SMALL CLUB, BIG TALENT CLEAN UP AT YORKSHIRE WINTER COMPETITION

Skipton Swimming Club delivered an outstanding performance at the Yorkshire Winter Competition this October.

Held across two prestigious venues - John Charles Centre for Sport in Leeds and Ponds Forge International Sports Centre in Sheffield.

Our swimmers showcased exceptional talent across both upper and lower age groups, securing an impressive haul of medals.

The upper age group proved particularly dominant, with **Jack Barnes** leading the charge by claiming **gold** in the **14 Yrs 50m Breaststroke** and **silver** in the **14 Yrs 100m Breaststroke**.

Olivia Batty added to the medal tally with silver in the 14 Yrs 50m Fly, whilst Stanley Dunne secured bronze in the 15 Yrs 100m Breaststroke.

Quinn Austin Kelly rounded out the upper age group successes with **bronze** in the **16 Yrs & Over 100m Breaststroke**.

The lower age groups were equally impressive, with Will Barnes dominating the 12 Yrs category by winning gold in the 50m Breaststroke and silver in the 100m Breaststroke.

Una O'Carroll and **Gray Chamley** both earned **bronze** medals in the **11/12 Yrs** and **12 Yrs 50m Breaststroke** respectively.

Particularly noteworthy were first-time Yorkshire competitors **Chris Gunkel** and **Ernie Quinn** from the 9/10 Yrs age group, who competed across multiple disciplines - a testament to the club's strong pipeline of emerging talent.


