Huge congratulations to our squad swimmers Sam Smith and Jack Jenkinson who have been selected to represent Team England at the **Swedish Grand Prix 2025** taking place in Stockholm in March.

This amazing opportunity is provided as part of the <u>Diploma in Sporting Excellence</u> (DiSE), a programme delivered by Swim England in conjunction with Loughborough College and forms the fifth stage of the Swim England Development Pathway, aligned with the Youth Performance squad. Both swimmers were selected for this programme and are currently in their second year completing the course alongside A Levels. Criteria for the selection to the Swedish Grand Prix includes a upward performance trajectory in the pool and a minimum Male 650+ WAP.

Swim England Changing Room Rules:

Respect Privacy:

Always use cubicles if additional privacy is required and be considerate of others in shared spaces. Inappropriate behavior is not tolerated.

• Maintain a Quiet Environment:

Keep noise levels to a minimum to ensure a calm atmosphere for all users.

Clean Up After Yourself:

Take all personal belongings, towels, and any rubbish with you when you leave the changing area.

Respect All Ages and Genders:

The facilities we use are shared by a diverse range of individuals. Ensure your behaviour is appropriate and considerate of everyone.

No Phones or Cameras:

The use of phones, cameras, or any recording devices is strictly prohibited in changing areas to protect everyone's privacy.

• Keep Conversations Appropriate:

Open conversations in the changing rooms should always remain respectful and suitable for all audiences.

We are absolutely thrilled to share the fabulous news about our Christmas fundraising raffle!


